As a Voorheesville local my entire life, I feel uniquely qualified to point out some of the one-of-a-kind opportunities our high school provides inside and outside the classroom, and as part of the Town of New Scotland.

For over 15 years, it has been a graduation requirement at Voorheesville Central High School that each student provide 15 hours of community service during their senior year. In my experience, this community service could be utilized by the community more than it currently is. Community service can be incredibly rewarding for both the student and the person or organization being served. It can be as simple as cleaning up the area around your local store, or as complex as helping set up a charity event with an organization. The only limitations are your imagination, and that it must have some element of doing good for the public.

AN OPPORTUNITY

If you see a street that needs cleaning, a job that needs doing, or a service that needs to be provided, before you look to the yellow pages, look to the High School. Local youth can help fuel local businesses and I encourage all of you to reach out to try to integrate your business with our local school! INFLATION AND COMMUNIAL RELATIONSHIPS

INFLATION AND COMMUNAL RELATIONSHIPS

As an English student with an extremely limited understanding of the economy, my grasp of inflation is largely derived from my weekly trips to Target incrementally becoming more expensive. For small businesses—specifically those that have carved out significant identities in their communities—without the resource reservoir, public perception and power of large corporations, the effects of inflation result in relatively high stakes.

Grace Thompson, owner of Gracie's Kitchen, cited the continuous influence of the COVID-19 pandemic as well as the comparatively unique economic conditions of small businesses as significant when approaching inflation from a business owner's perspective.

"While still recovering from the pandemic recession, we are unable to absorb the price increases seen all across the economy without passing that along to our consumer," Thompson wrote in an email. "It becomes increasingly difficult to balance our cost of doing business with providing a fairly priced, quality, enjoyable experience."

Local businesses are integral to the regions in which they belong, not only because they meet unmet needs, but also because of their social pull. It seems that, especially in smaller communities, local businesses have the social power to provide services beyond those they may have initially set out to perform, generally contributing to the environment and/or atmosphere on a broader scale.

Of course, this relationship emphasizes the positioning of the individuals who run and maintain the businesses. While discussing the service industry in particular, Thompson noted some of the effects of inflation that directly influence people seeking employment and/or making career moves to address said effects.

"Those who make their living in the service industry are facing the same higher cost of living we all are, and justifiably choose employment in those larger, higher priced venues where if the prices are higher, the wages and tips are likely to follow suit," wrote Thompson.

Inflation inherently has the effect of distancing businesses from the communities that they serve and in which they function. It can strain the relationship between local small businesses, their employees, and their customers: all community members. An issue as sweeping as inflation cannot be expected to be completely fixed on the level of the individual. In this sense especially, the existence of the New Scotland Business Community—the physical organization itself as well as the more explicit recognition of the community as a whole—is significant in its existence.

Thompson expressed the notion that individuals should engage with local businesses in the ways they are able to at the time.

"Mindful that all members of the New Scotland Business Community are your neighbors," wrote Thompson, "[you] can help by supporting each other and spreading the word."
